- Available to participate in training for this course commencing October 2021 via Zoom
- To commit to designing and delivering GRA training over the next four years

Desirable requirements

- Good working knowledge of the Garda code, discipline regulations, dispute resolution procedures, etc.
- Have sufficient IT skills to enable completion of course assignments and production of training content and materials.

It is envisaged the candidates, who successfully complete this training, along with the current GRA tutors will deliver GRA training in the coming years. Release, travel, subsistence, and accommodation will be arranged and provided.
